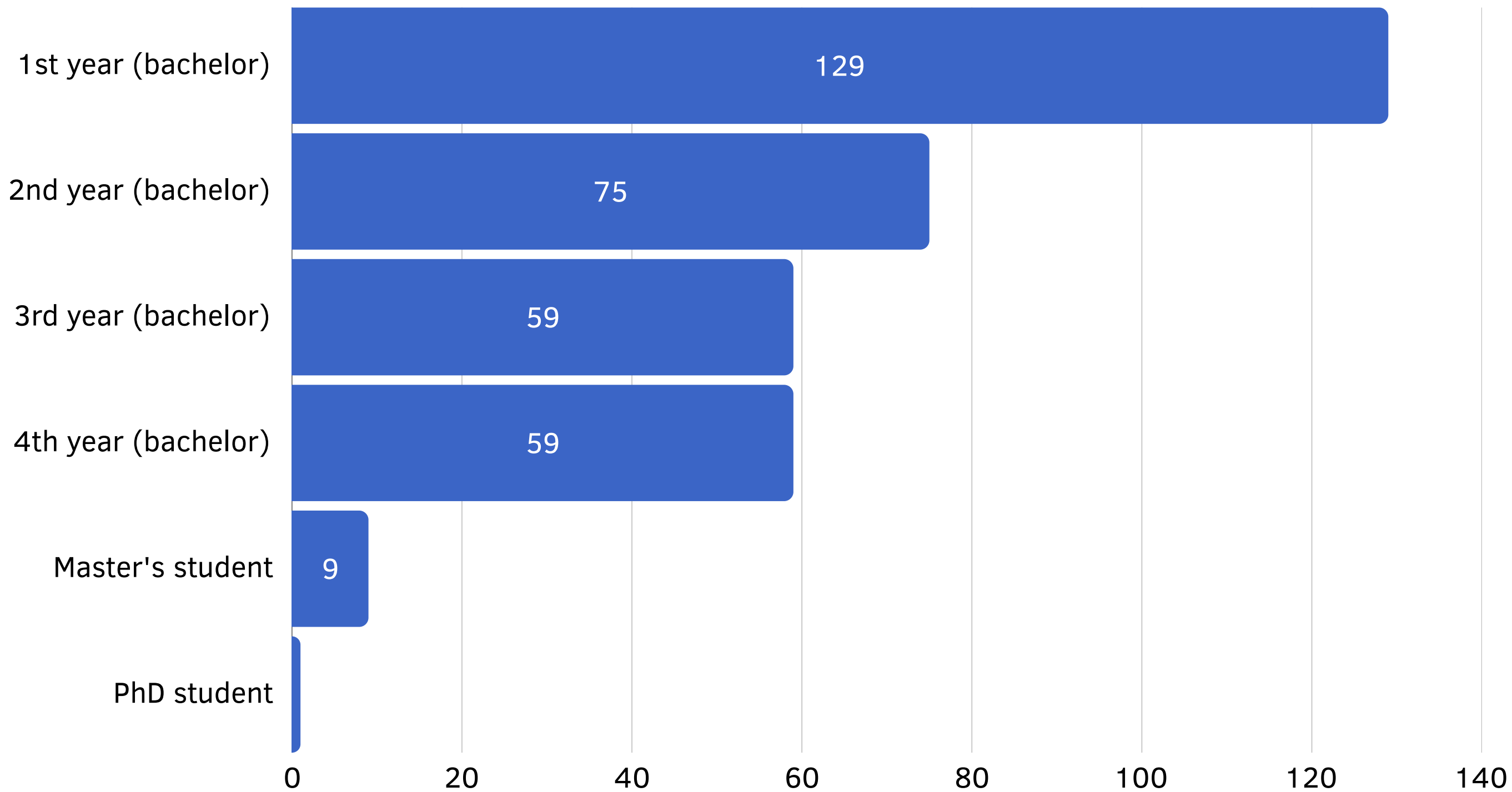
The questions were designed using a 5-point scale, where 1 means “completely dissatisfied” or "completely disagree" and 5 means “completely satisfied” or "completely agree".

Number of respondents: **332 responses.**



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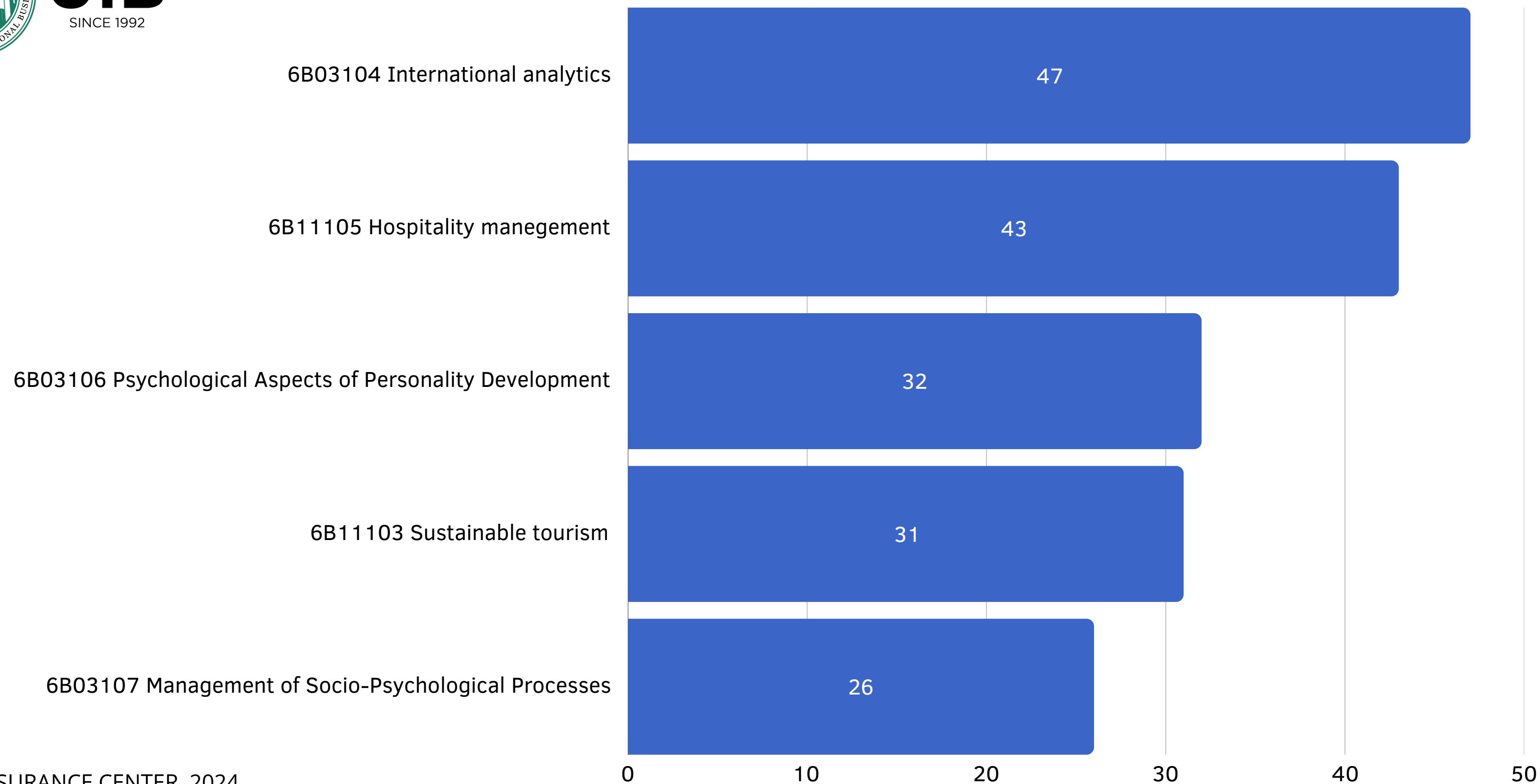
Distribution by Course and Level of Study
